Adverse weather contingency of normal school days in SBP (17 – 19 Aug, 2015)

- If a No.1 or No. 3 cyclone signal or Amber rainstorm signal is issued, the school will open as usual.
- If a No. 8 cyclone signal or above, Rainstorm Red or Black Warning, is issued before school hours, school will be closed. Students should stay home and need not go back to school while the warning is current.
- If No. 8 cyclone signal is replaced by a lower signal during the day, students do not have to return to school on that particular day.
- If a Pre-No.8 / No. 8 cyclone signal is issued during school hours, students will be picked up by parents or authorized persons, or arranged to leave the school with consent of parents.
- In general, if the Rainstorm Red or Black Warning is issued during school hours, students will stay in school for their safety. They will be picked up by parents or authorized persons, or arranged to leave the school with consent of parents. However, if there are exceptional personal circumstances, individual student can be released at the discretion of the Principal or the Organizing Committee.
- If Rainstorm Red or Black Warning is issued and then cancelled during school hours, students will continue with their normal lessons until the school closes.
- If the EDB makes a public announcement advising immediate suspension of classes, the school premises will remain open. Teachers will look after those students who are in school until arrangements are made for them to return home at an appropriate time. An announcement of school closure or suspension of classes does not necessarily mean that all students are to be sent home immediately.

Adverse weather contingency of Discipline Training Camp (20 – 21 Aug, 2015)

- In case of Typhoon Signal No. 1 or Rainstorm Amber Alert is hoisted on 20 Aug 2015, the Camp will go on.
- In case that Typhoon Signal No. 3 or above, Rainstorm Red or Black Warning, is issued before 7am on 20 Aug 2015, the Camp will be cancelled. Students should stay home and need not go back to school. The Organizing Committee will make announcement regarding further arrangement at school and PTA website.
- Once if Typhoon Signal No. 3 or above, Rainstorm Red or Black Warning is cancelled in the daytime of 20 Aug 2015, the Camp will resume and students are to come back to school shortly, and proceed to the Camp. The Organizing Committee will make announcement at school and PTA website.
- In case that Typhoon Signal No. 3 or above, is issued (or will probably be issued soon) during the Camp, the Camp will be terminated and students will be sent back to LSC by coaches shortly. Parents or authorized persons are to pick up the students in LSC. However, should there be exceptional personal circumstances, individual student may be dismissed in the Wu Kwai Sha Youth Village on discretion of the Organizing Committee together with consent of parents.
- If Rainstorm Red or Black Warning is issued during the Camp but is likely to be cancelled shortly by the Hong Kong Observatory, students will stay indoor in the Camp until cancellation of the warning and the Camp will continue afterwards.
- In case that Rainstorm Red or Black Warning is issued during the Camp, the Organizing Committee will refer to weather forecast of the Hong Kong Observatory and decide whether to terminate the Camp. If the Camp is to be terminated, students will be sent back to LSC by coaches shortly. Parents or authorized persons are to pick up the students in LSC. However, should there be exceptional personal circumstances, individual student may be dismissed in the Wu Kwai Sha Youth Village on discretion of the Organizing Committee together with consent of parents.
